To acknowledge the huge contribution Denis made to the Mater Hospital and celebrate his life the branch has commissioned a memorial bench which will be placed in the Atrium garden and unveiled in a gathering of the branch when restrictions are relaxed.

## **NHS Pay Rise - 2 Days for 2K**

UNISON, the biggest union in the NHS is calling for an immediate pay rise for all NHS workers. We have submitted a pay claim to the UK Government at Westminster calling for **all workers** to receive an increase of at least £2,000 before the end of the year. This is the equivalent of around £1 an hour for all staff. When we surveyed our members, 70% of our members said that a **£2,000** pay lift would make a 'substantial difference'. Your branch is playing a key role in advancing this campaign both at a regional level and at UK level. **Watch this space!**

## **Free School Meals For All**

UNISON is campaigning for the delivery of universal nutritious free school meals for all children.

## **Branch News**

### **Atrium ATM**

UNISON members have contacted the Branch regarding the charge of fee for transactions when using the ATM in the Atrium. We have contacted the Trust who have told us they will liaise with the providers to have this changed in the near future. We look forward to this!

### **Support services migration to Band 2**

UNISON knows only too well that our industrial action last year remains incomplete. The branch has ensured that the removal of Band 1 and the migration of all Band 1 staff onto Band 2 remains a top priority. Our members in support services have been inspirational during this pandemic and we will ensure our members get pay justice for their commitment to the NHS and the job they do.
